I have met with Margot again and wanted to articulate her concerns once more about her housing arrangement. Although the two parties are in different apartment units, they are in very close proximity to one another and can see into one another's apartments. They can also easily monitor each other's comings and goings with the potential of breaking the no contact order. There is only one entrance to and from the THs, making it easy to cross paths. Margot is feeling very unsafe and this is causing her great distress. She has supportive friends living with her and would like to remain in her current apartment.
